Don't be a Distracted Driver!

**Don't sacrifice convenience for safety**. Most of today's vehicles come with touch screens, audio, climate control, and phone interactions... but no call or convenience is worth your life or safety. Before you start your trip, make the adjustments or calls you need to make. Commit to driving without distractions.

**Device Overload.** When driving, put your devices away. Don't use your phone while driving, and enter your GPS addresses/coordinates before you start driving. Pull over or wait until your next stop to make a call or text.

<u>Silent distractions</u>. Sometimes the distraction is all in your head. Maybe you're thinking about your busy schedule, problems at work, or home tasks you need to complete.
